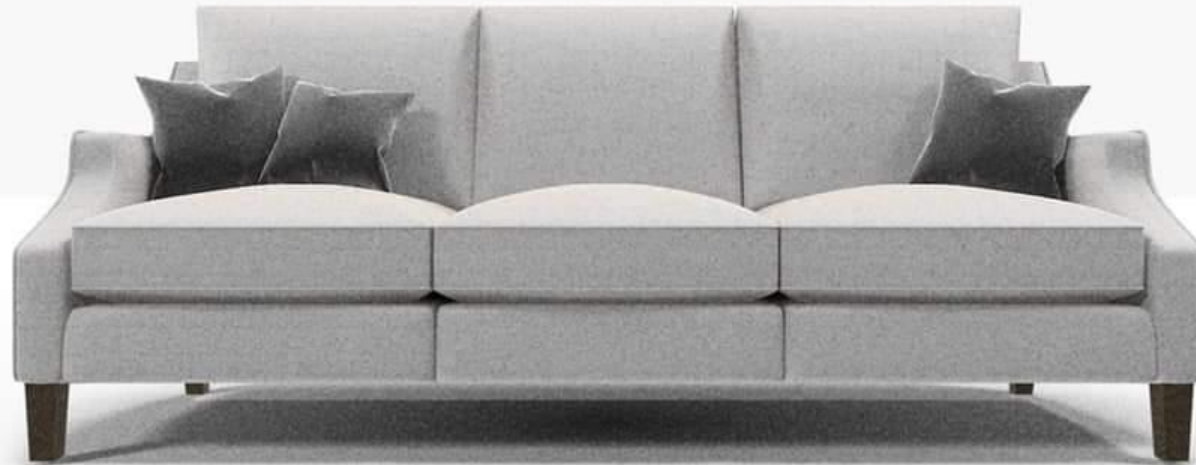

Video is important,
however **sound is key.**

For those of you already livestreaming

Inclusion is important, think about those
camera shots

Some thoughts:

- Open with a square on, tight eye level shot.
- Say hello to those at home / online.
- Introduce yourself.

Some thoughts:

- Always show the leader at the start of the song. (Visual clue)
- Switch shots based on tempo, at sensible points
- Mark key points during rehearsal (Drum fill)
